

The Legend of Bierzo

Spanish culture with its rich history and tradition is produced in every bottle of our Bierzo wine. Excellent wine has been produced in the region since the XI century due to the favorable climate, fertile soils and natural water resources. Bierzo's location on the Atlantic coast of Spain is in a sheltered valley on the northwestern boundary of the province of Leon, in the autonomous region of Castilla y Leon. "El Bierzo" is formed by a collection of small towns due north of Portugal.

During medieval times, disputing territorial leaders fought for the El Bierzo region. Benedictine Monks settled there under Cluny and made delicious red wine from the grapes grown in the mineral based soils of the river valley.

The Agribergidvm Cellar and its vineyards are located in the Saint James of Compostela Way, by the foot of an old Roman Castro called "CASTRO BERGIDVM". This castro was the administrative center during the Roman occupation. It was here the Romans mined their gold. Indeed, these historical notes of interesting intensity and golden memories add character and extraordinary spirit to our Bierzo wine.

Odorus Godello

Produced in the hillsides of an old Celtic settlement, which was later conquered by the Romans called "Castro Bergidum" Godello grapes is the variety which best expresses the smell and taste of EL BIERZO. The land is acid and the hillsides are orientated to catch the sun's rays. Odorus is characterized by its straw color and has a fresh, natural citric apple aroma. Elaborated with 100% Godello grapes, and hand selected from the oldest vineyards and land; Fermented at low temperatures to extract fullest flavor. Unique color with greenish edgings. To the nose, very explosive with floral aromas with a touch of citric flavor. To the mouth, a balanced flavor.

Castro Bergidvm Mencia

Its cherry red color with violet shades denotes its youth. On the nose, it is intense with primary aromas well defined of candied fruits, cherry, blackberry and wet soil. On the palate, it is persistent, fresh and smooth which is reminiscent of the Bierzo land. It is elaborated with 100% Mencia grapes, selected from our vineyards located in the hills of Pieros and Cacabelos, witnesses of the pilgrimage of thousands of pilgrims in their journey towards Santiago de Compostela.
